How do I start a group?

We would love for you to start a group! You can start your group by visiting www.churchnativity.com/lead - complete the application. You can do that today or stop at Next Steps Kiosk during one of the weekend services and we can help. Please note we do comply with the background check process for all of the Archdiocese of Baltimore and will require you to provide references and complete the video training curriculum prior to serving.
